PRIVACY POLICY OF THE WEBSITE EN.SMART-OSVITA.ORG BY NGO SMART OSVITA

The present Privacy Policy is valid for the EN.SMART-OSVITA.ORG website (hereinafter referred to as the Website). The NGO Smart Osvita shall be personal data controller and administrator in accordance with the present Policy.

The content of the website may contain links to other websites. The NGO Smart Osvita assumes no responsibility for the Privacy Policy or content of these websites.

Personal Data Collection

The following types of personal data shall be subject to collection, storage and use:

- Information on your PC, including your IP address, geographic location, browser type and version, and operating system;

- Information on your visits and use of this website, including referral sources, length of visits, pages viewed and website navigation paths;

- Information you entered when you created a profile on our website, such as your name, profile picture, sex, date of birth, marital status, hobbies and interests, education and employment, and social media ID;

- Information contained in any communications you have sent to the NGO Smart Osvita by email or through our website, including the content of the message and metadata;

The NGO Smart Osvita does not verify the accuracy of the information received about users and does not control the legal personality of users.

Prior to disclosure of a third-party personal information to us, you must obtain the consent of that person to both disclose and process this information in accordance with these rules.

Use of Personal Information

The NGO Smart Osvita uses your personal data for the following purposes:

- Our website administration;
- Our website personalisation for you;
- Enabling you to use the services available on our website;
- Sending you email newsletters, if you have requested them (you can inform us at any time that you no longer wish to receive email newsletters from us);
- Providing third-party companies with statistical information on our users (however, these third-party companies will not be able to identify any individual user from this data);
- Handling enquiries and complaints made by or about you and relating to our website;
- To ensure the security of our website and prevent fraud;
- For other purposes.

Personal Information Disclosure

The NGO Smart Osvita reserves the right to disclose your personal information:

- In the case of the user's consent;
- In cases required by law;

To detect and prevent fraudulent activities, as well as to solve security problems and troubleshoot technical issues.

Personal Information Protection

The NGO Smart Osvita will take sufficient technical and organisational measures to prevent the loss, misuse or falsification of your personal information;

You acknowledge that you are aware of the fact that the transmission of information over the Internet is inherently unprotected and we cannot guarantee the protection of data sent over the World Wide Web.

You are solely responsible for keeping your password to access our website confidential. We will never ask you for your password (except when you attempt to log in to your account on our website).

Personal Data Subject Rights

You shall be entitled:

To know about the sources of collection, location of your personal data, the purpose of their processing, location or place of residence (stay) of the personal data owner or manager or to give a corresponding order to obtain this information to persons authorised by them, except in cases established by law;

To receive information on the terms and conditions for granting access to personal data, including information on third parties to whom their personal data is transferred;

To have access to your personal data;

To receive a response on whether their personal data is being processed not later than thirty calendar days from the date of receipt of the request, except in cases provided for by law, and receive the content of such personal data;

To submit a reasoned request to the personal data controller with an objection to the processing of their personal data;

To submit a reasoned request to change or destroy their personal data by any personal data owner and manager if this data is processed illegally or is unreliable;

To protect their personal data from unlawful processing and accidental loss, destruction, damage due to intentional concealment, failure to provide or untimely provision, as well as to protect against the provision of information that is inaccurate or discrediting the honour, dignity and business reputation of an individual;

To lodge complaints about the processing of their personal data with the Ukrainian Parliament Commissioner for Human Rights or a court;

To apply for legal remedies in case of violation of the legislation on personal data protection;

To make reservations regarding the restriction of the right to process their personal data when granting consent;

To withdraw consent to the personal data processing;

To know the mechanism of automatic personal data processing;

To be protected from an automated decision that has legal consequences for them.

Copyright

All exclusive property and non-property rights to textual materials, photos, images and other copyright objects posted on this site shall be owned by the NGO Smart Osvita, except for copyright objects that contain a direct indication of the authorship of another person;

The use of textual materials on the website shall be allowed only with a link (for online publications - a hyperlink) to the source. The use of photos and images without the consent of the editorial board is strictly prohibited;

In the event of any copyright infringement, the NGO Smart Osvita shall be entitled to bring the offender to justice in accordance with the law.

Cookies.

Our website uses cookies. A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a web page from the server. Cookies can be either “persistent” or “session”: persistent cookies will be stored by the browser and will remain valid until the expiry date unless deleted by the user in advance; “session” cookies will be deleted after the end of the session with the website or after the browser is closed. Cookies usually do not contain any information that identifies the user. However, the personal information we hold about you may be linked to information stored in and obtained from cookies;

Most browsers give you the option to refuse the use of cookies.

Blocking all cookies will have a negative impact on the user experience of many websites. If you block cookies, you may not be able to use many features of our website.

We reserve the right to amend the Website Privacy Policy periodically and publish the new version on our website.
